A. ORGANIZATION. The AC Milan Academy Junior Camp of Cortina d'Ampezzo (Alps - Dolomites), Asiago Mountain Plateau - Gallio (Alps), Jesolo Lido (Venice) and Lignano Sabbiadoro (Venice Area) are organized by ASD Sporteventi, Via Pastore, 44, 31029, Vittorio Veneto (TV), Italy.

B. AC MILAN ACADEMY JUNIOR CAMP - JUNIOR formula. This is the AC Milan-residential-formula camp with hotel staying for the participants. The subscription cost of the week rotation period of the AC Milan Junior Camp is inclusive of full board and lodging in hotel, from Sunday at 2 pm (lunch not included) to Saturday at 1 pm (lunch included), sports kit marked AC Milan Academy – Puma – Fly Emirates, daily washing of (only) the AC Milan Training T-shirts, shorts and socks (no underwear), transportation by private coach to and from the football pitch and Third Part Civil Liability; this cost doesn't include the week-end stay (from Saturday 1 pm to Sunday 2 pm); this extra-fee is not compulsory. Prices are all inclusive except for telephone calls and drinks. **In case of participation at two camps in a row the AC Milan-kit will be assigned to the camper only once.**

C. MILAN JUNIOR CAMP - DAY formula. This is the AC Milan Junior Camp without staying overnight for the participants, envisaged for those who can reach easily the site of the camp every day. The subscription cost includes lunches (no breakfasts and dinners), sports kit marked AC Milan Academy - Puma - Fly Emirates, daily washing of (only) the AC Milan Training T-shirts, shorts and socks (no underwear), transportation by private coach to and from the football pitch, Third Part Civil Liability. Prices are all inclusive except for telephone calls and drinks. **In case of participation at two camps in a row the AC Milan-kit will be assigned to the camper only once.**

D. ARRIVAL TIME. In no case will the camper be taken over by the Sporteventi staff before the start of the camp (at 2.00 pm on Sunday); parents and / or carers will have to look after the children until the mentioned time (surveillance and food) even if they arrive at the camp site on Sunday morning.

E. FINALIZATION OF THE ENROLLMENT PROCESS.

The enrolment process is not considered concluded if:

- 1) the minor at the accreditation (check-in) of the AC Milan Junior Camp does not provide a negative antigenic swab dated no later than 48 hours prior to the time of accreditation itself or is symptomatic about COVID at check-in;
- 2) the parent refuses to sign the attachments of the entry form (DVR - risk assessment document; privacy policy; release for the use of audio/video and photographic recordings; healthcare proxy; declaration of responsibility; COVID-19 self-certification).

In hypotheses 1) and 2) the amount paid will not be returned.

By signing the Risk Assessment Document, parents/guardians undertake to respect the requirements that apply to them.

F. HEALTH CERTIFICATE. Please provide together with this application-form a medical certificate (Family Doctor's Clean Bill of Health) where a doctor recognized by the National Health System, having examined the child/boy, states:

- not having diagnosed any clinical signs restraining the practice - in competition or not - of the football/soccer and specifically of the football/soccer sport activities named as Milan Junior Camp which is a not-agonistic-summer-football camp for children/boys aged 8-17;
- that the electrocardiogram (ECG), if needed, doesn't show any sign of detectable illness / disease;
- that the subject does not show any sign of detectable contagious illness / disease.

The medical certificate, not older than one year from the beginning of the camp, must cover the entire period of the camp, otherwise the registration will be cancelled.

Nobody will be admitted to the camp without the Health Certificate or with a wrong one.

G. CALL-OFF. The entire registration fee (less admin fee) will be returned upon cancellation by the subscriber, if communicated by email at least 30 days before the start date of the chosen AC Milan Junior Camp, no refund less than 30 days before camp. In case the participant should tests positive at COVID test, proven by a positive antigenic swab, the registration can be cancelled up to the day before the start-date of the chosen camp. In the event of an injury or illness, proven by a medical certificate, the registration can be cancelled up to the day before the start date of the chosen camp. Under no circumstances will anything be refunded once the camp has started.

H. INTERRUPTION OF AC MILAN JUNIOR CAMP. It is understood that, in the event of interruption of the AC Milan Junior Camp for health reasons, at any time it occurs, the amount paid will not be returned even in part.

- I. RELIEF FROM RESPONSIBILITY AND DAMAGES.** I, the undersigned _____, as the parent exercising parental authority over my son _____, under my personal responsibility I declare to expressly waive ASD Sporteventi and each one of its employees and / or appointed person from any liability for any damage arising from events that are caused exclusively by my son (including, by way of example yet not comprehensive, not authorized independent initiatives taken by my son during his stay at the AC Milan Junior Camp), or by circumstances beyond the supply of the services offered (such as, but not limited to, the transfer to and from the chosen location, if not included in the attendance fee), by accident, force majeure, or by circumstances that the ASD Sporteventi itself could not, with the due professional diligence, reasonably foresee or resolve. I furthermore declare to relieve ASD SPORTEVENTI and any member of its staff or appointed person from any responsibility for damages that the camper/child should cause during the stage of the AC Milan Junior Camp. In any case should damages occur to premises and hotel equipment they will be charged to the camper/child who will be found responsible for them, or, if not possible, shared equally among the roommates.
- J. CHARGE AUTHORIZATON.** In the event that your camper/child requires urgent medical care, as determined by ASD Sporteventi as Manager of the AC Milan Junior Camp, your credit card may be charged the cost of such care/treatment, or pay for any damages to the facilities used by ASD Sporteventi as Manager of the Milan Junior Camp caused by your camper/child, or with your prior approval (your email may serve as such) pay for additional classes, offerings or services. All fees to be in Euros.
- K. EXPRESS CANCELLATION CLAUSE.** In the event that during the time at the Milan Junior Camp as well as during the stay in the hotel, the registrant's behaviour breaks in any way the normal rules of civil cohabitation or are against the rules given by the guides/trainers, then said registrant may be removed from the AC Milan Junior Camp and this contract will be considered legally cancelled therefore ASD SPORTEVENTI will be allowed to retain all amounts received by it and to legally demand compensation.
It is also underlined that the operators of the AC Milan Junior Camp do not have the professional skills to be able to manage situations of mental distress or mental disorder in a broad sense.

INSURANCE INCLUDED

- Supervisors. Supervisors are former AC Milan players of proven national and international fame and prestige or coaches or managers of crucial importance They live with campers during relaxation moments, while eating, in and out of soccer field.*
- Assistance 24 hours a day. Coaches and assistants of the camp, qualified and specialized personnel, selected by Sporteventi managers, live in the hotel with the boys and supervise the rooms also at night.*
- Assistants. At the Milan Junior Camp one or two female assistants are present in particular to take care of the campers injured and of the youngest participants who might be missing their mothers.*
- Transfer service. We guarantee transfer services with a private bus from the hotel to the soccer pitches and back.*
- Bottled Mineral water distribution. Bottled Mineral water is always available in the playing field.*
- Healthy food. Food is very important and that is why the delicious "Bibanesi" are always present as main courses, a guarantee of quality. Twice a day, at mid-morning and midafternoon, the boys of the camp will have snacks.*
- Ongoing washing of the AC Milan Kit. The sports garment of the AC Milan Kit are numbered to be easily recognizable by their respective owners and are therefore always washed to ensure top hygiene conditions.*

Information concerning the processing of personal data pursuant to articles 13 and 14 of the Regulation EU 2016/679

Dear Madame / Sir,

In your capacity as a "Data Subject", that is, as the individual to whom the data processing refers, or as the "Responsible" party, we wish to inform you of a series of information relating to the ways personal data is used.

Purpose of the processing:

The collection and processing of personal data are carried out in order to conduct:

1. the fulfilment of all operations imposed by regulatory obligations;
2. the establishment and execution of current contractual relationships, including the acquisition of information prior to the conclusion of the Contract;
3. the management of relations with the Client for administration, accounting, invoicing, and management of any litigation;

Personal data will be processed according to the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of your privacy and your rights.

Processing methods:

The processing of data for the purposes set out above takes place in an automated fashion, with the support of electronic media, and on paper by means of operations involving the collection, registration, organization, storage, consultation, processing, use and deletion of data.

Processing location:

Mandatory or optional nature of the provision of data:

Consequences of a refusal to provide data:

Communication of data:

No right to vote is given to an associate that **have not yet reached the age of consent (18 years old)**. However, he/she will be allowed to participate to members’ meeting.

COVID-19 information and rules (DVR – RISK ASSESMENT DOCUMENT)

Participants

The participants are children/young people aged 6–17.

Each young person (both residential or not) will be admitted as a participant of the AC Milan Junior Camp after testing negative on a COVID-19 antigenic test (rapid swab) dated no later than 48 hours prior to the time of accreditation of the camp and not being symptomatic about COVID at check-in of the camp.

Once a participant has joined the camp, he will stay overnight and eat at the hotel within his group.

Day-Formula participants (not residential) will be admitted to the camp after testing negative on a COVID-19 antigenic test (rapid swab) dated no later than 48 hours prior to the time of accreditation of the camp and not being symptomatic about COVID at check-in of the camp.

Each participant's details will be registered, and the register will be kept for at least 14 days from the last day of the camp.

Participants' parents/guardians

Parents/guardians will be able to interact with participants after the start of the camp:

- Preferably outdoors
- Without accessing the hotel rooms where the participants are staying overnight
- Without accessing the gyms where participants play sports in the event of bad weather
- Without accessing the means of transport that the participants use to access activities
- Without accessing the football activity area.

Participant health

Upon arrival, the parent or guardian will declare and guarantee that the participant:

- Has not tested positive and is not under quarantine.
- Has not had any respiratory symptoms such as a cough, or other symptoms such as a headache, diarrhoea, loss of taste or smell, or impaired health within the past 3 days.
- Does not have a body temperature over 37,5°.
- Is not self-isolating after close contact with someone who has tested positive.
- Is not self-isolating after returning or entering from other countries, where required by law.

We strongly recommend that potential participants have reduced social contact during the 7 days leading up to the camp, avoiding risky situations such as crowded enclosed spaces.

Kit

On the Sunday at the start of the camp, all the participants will be assigned with clothing and provided with an identification number.

Upon delivery, the staff will make a visual assessment of the size of the garments previously assigned to the participants, without the latter touching them.

Once the kits have been assigned, the garments will remain with the participant and cannot be changed.

Clothes washing

The kits will be placed in washing bags by the participants and collected by the staff, who will allow the participants to place them in a trolley. This transfer will take place at the doorways of the rooms, with the trolley passing through the corridor.

The marked bags will then be entrusted to an external laundry service.

Participant arrival

All minors must arrive accompanied by their parent or guardian or by a person delegated by the family.

Participants should arrive around 14:00. The participants will be assigned a number. Participants will undergo hand sanitisation, a temperature check and the check of a COVID-19 antigenic test (rapid swab) - testing negative - dated no later than 48 hours prior to the time of accreditation of the camp.

Parents cannot access the hotel rooms (never) and the lobby (during the check-in).

Participants will be assigned an overnight room where, with the help of the staff, they can leave their luggage and be assigned their kit.

The overnight rooms and the group occupying them will remain the same throughout the camp.

Hand sanitising

The following sanitisation times have been identified, at which each participant's hands will be dosed with sanitiser by a staff member or independently under supervision:

- When arriving at the breakfast room
- When leaving the breakfast room
- When boarding the transport to the pitch
- When getting off the transport before starting activities at the pitch
- When boarding the transport to return for lunch
- When arriving back at the hotel
- When arriving at the lunch room
- When leaving the lunch room
- When boarding the transport to the pitch
- When getting off the transport before starting activities at the pitch
- When boarding the transport to return for lunch
- When arriving back at the hotel
- When arriving at the dinner room
- When leaving the dinner room
- Before the evening walk/activity
- When returning from the evening walk/activity

The staff will then check that the participants have correctly applied the sanitiser to their hands, rubbing it in thoroughly.

Temperature checks

Participants will undergo a temperature check in the morning before accessing breakfast.

Participants will undergo a temperature check in the evening when entering the room.

An infrared thermometer will be used to measure their temperature.

Transport

Bus transport is provided to transfer participants between the hotel and the playing field.

The means of transport is equipped with a certified sanitisation system that prevents air recirculation, making the risk of infection extremely low.

Football activities on the pitch (outdoors)

During football activities on the pitch, the provisions related to contact sports apply.

The public cannot be present during the activities inside the pitch.

Participants will leave the hotel in their kit, ready for activities.

Each participant must have their own clearly marked water bottle for their exclusive use.

Sports activities in the gym

In the event of bad weather, sports activities will be held in the gym. In this case, contact sports are permitted.

The public cannot be present during the activities.

Participants will leave the hotel in their kit, ready for activities.

Each participant must have their own clearly marked water bottle for their exclusive use.

Non-sports activities

The non-sports activities consist of walks in the surrounding area (sea or mountains), outings in the city centre or in neighbouring open spaces.

The relevant protocols for the activities in which they are participating will apply.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner

Meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) for participants and staff will be served within the hotel.

While meals are being served, the protocol for hotel catering will apply.

The diners seated at a given table must be from the same overnight room.

The staff will have their meals seated at their own table.

Management of suspected COVID-19 cases

Case 1 A participant experiences a fever, cough, or loss of smell and taste during the camp:

- If a participant is found to be feverish (over 37.5 °C with an infrared thermometer and confirmed with an axillary thermometer) or has typical symptoms such as an intense cough or loss of smell and taste:

- The family will be informed.
- The staff will wear FFP2, goggles, and gloves.
- The participant will wear an FFP2 mask and sanitise their hands.
- The participant will be accompanied to an outpatient clinic
- The participant will sit in the back of the car.
- The car must be sanitised, in particular the handles and any other areas touched by the participant.
- If the problem arises at night, the participant will be isolated in the COVID room, with hourly temperature checks. If their temperature rises above 38.5 °C, or if other symptoms not attributable to a fever from fatigue appear, a doctor must be contacted.
- If he/she is positive for COVID-19: the family will be informed and the participant in the COVID-room will be isolated until they can return to their family. The room will be guarded by a staff member with the aforementioned PPE.
- If he/she is negative for COVID-19: the family will be informed that the participant tests negative and the participant will remain under observation; the doctor will be called should any further symptoms appear.
- In case of other relevant symptoms, the doctor will be contacted immediately.
- The roommates are tested and kept under observation, wearing mask FFP2 indoor for 5 days if testing negative.

Check-out

The participants and their luggage will be handed over to their families by the staff on Saturday, from the morning through to 14:00, outside the hotel lobby.

From that moment on, the minors will no longer be participants of the Milan Junior Camp
